1. Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts. Right of the 10th tee box, all of 11th Fairway. Practice Ground and Practice Holes beyond the line of the white posts, left of the 11th fairway and to the right of the 16th.
2. Ground under repair: Play Prohibited. Ground under repair is defined by any area encircled by a white line. Free relief must be taken (Rule 16.1).
3. Protection of young trees: the young trees identified by stakes are No Play Zones: if a player has any type of interference as defined in Rule 16.1 from such a tree designated as a No Play Zone, he or she must take relief under Rule 16.1f.
4. Fixed sprinkler heads:
  - relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1.Ball in General Area:
  - the player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, and is either within two club-lengths of the putting green or within two clublengths of the ball.
5. Bridges are part of the penalty area Rule 17.1a. The ball may be played as it lies (Rule 17.1b) with no penalty or you may take penalty relief (Rule 17.1d). All roads and paths on the course are treated as immovable obstructions which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
6. Overhead cable (Valley 13th): if it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line during play, the stroke does not count. The player must play a ball without penalty from where the previous stroke was made (Rule 14.6).
7. Tree roots: if a player's ball in the general area has interference from tree roots in the fairway or in the rough within two club-lengths of the fairway, free relief is available under Rule 16.1b.
8. Dropping Zones Valley Hole 7: if a ball is in the penalty area (river or on bridge), the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
  - take relief under Rule 17.1, or
  - drop the original ball or another ball in the designated dropping zone.
9. No Play Zone Valley Hole 12: the area behind the Valley 12th Green (Blue posts) is a No Play Zone and the player must take free relief under Rule 16.1f(2) using the designated dropping zone which is a relief area under Rule 14.3.
